4-H CAMP BRISTOL HILLS MOVING FORWARD WITH PLANS FOR SUMMER CAMP

With Governor Cuomo's announcement on February 17 that Residential Summer Camps in New York State can plan to reopen in June, 4-H Camp Bristol Hills is preparing to welcome campers back this summer! Now in its 96th season, 4-H Camp Bristol Hills continues to offer a variety of quality summer programs for youth ages 5-16. The camp is located 10 miles south of Canandaigua in the beautiful Bristol Hills region of the Finger Lakes. It is owned and operated by Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ontario County, licensed by the New York State Department of Health, and accredited by the American Camp Association. 4-H Camp Bristol Hills is open to all interested youth.

4-H Camp Bristol Hills features outdoor recreation and environmental education activities including ropes courses, cooking, crafts, STEM, fishing, hiking, archery and riflery, and sports. The camp experience is rounded out with general camp fun of cabin living, picnic meals, visits to the camp store, and more.

This year the camp offers a variety of unique program options for interested youth:

- Day Camps for youth going into Kindergarten through 2nd grade.
- Progression Camp (Day program for youth going into 3rd grade and up.
- Resident Camp for youth going into 3rd grade and up.
- Young Women's Adventure Camp for girls going into 6th through 9th grades.
- Master Camp in Animation for campers in 6th grade or higher.
- Adventure Camp (Ropes Course) for older youth going into 6th grade or higher.
- Leader-In-Training sessions for youth who are 15 years of age.
- Counselor in Training sessions for youth who are 16 years of age

4-H Camp Bristol Hills will be holding open houses on Saturday April 17, Saturday May 8 and Sunday June 13.

Tours will be offered by appointment only this year. The Open House will give interested youth and parents with an opportunity to meet staff, tour camp, and have their questions answered.
