

**RESOLUTION #58-18: AUTHORIZATION TO HIRE PUBLIC WORKS MAINTENANCE ASSISTANCE**

WHEREAS, the Town of Seneca has a job opening for a full-time Public Works Maintenance Assistant; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Seneca has advertised for this position, accepted applications, and interviewed multiple candidates approved by the Ontario County Department of Human Resources; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Seneca hereby approves the hiring of Tyler Cosentino to fill the full-time Public Works Maintenance Assistant position at an hourly rate of \$19.00 to be charged to the budget line SW1-8340.1 (Transmission & Distribution Personal Services).

**RESOLUTION #59-18: AUTHORIZE TOWN HALL FENCE REPAIR**

WHEREAS, the fencing along the southern property line of Town Hall sustained damage from the weather and is in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, the Code Enforcement Officer has requested and received two written quotes for this repair and recommends Reale Fence, Inc; and

WHEREAS, Reale Fence, Inc has submitted Fencing Proposal #2714 detailing this repair for a total cost of \$1,469.70; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Seneca hereby authorizes Reale Fence, Inc to complete the fencing repair for a total cost not to exceed \$1,469.70.

**RESOLUTION #60-18: SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 5 & 20 ACCESS ROAD BETWEEN FRIENDLY FORD AND HARLEY-DAVIDSON; AND SEQR INTENT TO DECLARE LEAD AGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Seneca (herein after referred to as "Town Board") is considering the construction of a 5 & 20 access road running up to 300 feet to the south between Friendly Ford and Geneva Harley-Davidson; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board would like to hear from residents about the proposed construction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board wishes to continue with this portion of the project that was previously approved as part of the construction of Friendly Ford; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board intends to determine said proposed Local Law is classified as an Unlisted Action under the SEQR Regulations per §617 of the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation Law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board intends to declare itself as the Lead Agency on the proposed action; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Town Board of the Town of Seneca hereby establishes a public hearing for the proposed Local Law to be held on June 19, 2018 at 7:30pm at the Seneca Town Hall located at 3675 Flint Road Stanley, NY 14561 in the meeting room; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Town Board directs the Code Enforcement Officer to send notification the New York State Department of Transportation Regional Office; and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, the Town Clerk is directed to provide notice of said public hearing.
